**Eligibility:**

All Galveston County Public, Private & Homeschooled High School students are invited to participate in the Chalk It Up art competition.

Art Teachers from all schools are encouraged to register teams of individual students or teams of two students may participate.

**The following Awards will be presented to top 3 winning teams or individual students: If you have a team of two prize money will be split between participants.**

**1st Place \$200 • 2nd Place \$100 • 3rd Place \$50**

**How To Participate In 2024:**

We want to make sure that all schools and individuals have an opportunity to participate.

- We have a total of 20 spaces for participation for individual students or teams of two
  - Complete a chalk piece (3ft x 3ft square) at School/home, prior to The Grand Kids Festival. Completion and submittal no later than Monday April 15, 2024.

**Chalk It Up! Application Process:**

- Submit a Registration Form for each individual student or 2 student team
  - Completed at School or home

Deadline to Enter is Monday April 15, 2024 (only the first 20 individuals or teams registered will be able to participate).

*Confirmation of Team Status will be sent via email upon receipt of application.*

## **Completed at School or home**

**Entry Deadline:** April 15, 2024

Team or Teams must complete their pieces in **at school or home**

- All materials to be picked up at The Grand 1894 Opera House Office on March 25, 2024 from 2:30pm-5:00pm.
- Students are encouraged to watch instructional videos on YouTube to refine their chalk drawing skills.
- Participants Artwork must be delivered to The Grand no later than Monday, April 15, 2024 between 9am-5pm.
- The Grand Kids Festival will photograph these entries and place on The Grand Kids Festival Facebook Page. <https://www.facebook.com/TheGrandKidsFestival>
- All entries will be hung in the window of the Grand 1894 Opera house event room (Edna's Room)
- Entries will be voted on the day of the Festival by attendees. Voting station will be located in front of windows where drawings are hung.
- Winner of prizes will be announced on Monday after Festival on the Grand Kids Festival Facebook page. All prizes will be distributed to students at their school or may be picked up at the Grand 1894 Opera House. You will be contacted regarding these arrangements.
- Student artist teams will create a chalk drawing measuring 3ft x 3ft on a piece of roofing paper and supplies that will be provided by The Grand Kids Festival. All supplies may be picked up at The Grand starting March 25, 2024 between 9am to 5pm
- Judging of all entries will be by Festival attendees and will be completed on Saturday April 20, 2024. Announcement of winners will be the Monday following the Festival. Winners will be listed on the Grand Kids Festival Facebook page. The Festival will contact all winners. All prizes will be distributed to students at their school or may be picked up at the Grand 1894 Opera House. You will be contacted regarding these arrangements.

## **Important Tips From The Chalk Pros:**

- We think the possibilities are endless
- Grid your image ahead of time: Since you are working in such a large space it is easy to get lost in your drawing and become confused about where everything needs to go. Create a grid of your image beforehand to help you stay on track during the competition.
- Guidelines for choosing art for street chalk drawing: The primary goal for choosing an image is the pop: an image, a color scheme, and an idea that is electric. Your work must be original. You will be working in a 3ft by 3ft square so keep that in mind when picking your team's image.
- Use hairspray on your artwork to keep the chalk from smearing or smudging.
